In English this week, we have been looking at the active and passive voice to create a more informative tone in our writing. We have also been working on creating the appropriate tone in our information writing – making sure it is both accessible yet informative and uses enough technical vocabulary.

In Maths we have just finished our work on fractions and consolidated this learning by solving fraction word problems. We have just started looking at perimeter of shapes.

In science, we have been looking at the distance between the planets and represented these in a pocket-sized solar system.

In geography we have now researched the human and physical features of 3 different mountain ranges – Snowdonia, The Alps and The Andes.
