In maths we've continued working on column addition and subtraction but progressed to word problems and deciding which operation we need to use.

In PSHE we've started a topic called celebrating difference. The first lesson focused on making assumptions about people which raised lots of good discussions.

Home Learning

Projects:

Please choose two of the following options to complete over the second half of the Autumn Term. This will be due in Friday 20th December 2024. You are welcome to do more than two if you wish.

1. Science: Create your own drawing or model of the ear. It must include the different parts that make up the ear and be coloured or painted. Write an explanation to go with your model or drawing to explain how the ear works.
2. RE: We have learnt about the story of Noah and will be learning about the story of Adam and Eve in the next couple of weeks. Create your own story board for one of the above to retell each section of the story.
3. History 1: We have studied the Stone Age in Britain during which time people used wood, wool and bone amongst other materials to make jewellery. Research Stone Age jewellery then design and make your own. Make sure you are able to share a few facts about stone age jewellery.
4. History option 2: We will be studying the Bronze Age and moving into the Iron Age between now and Christmas. Research Iron Age hill forts and make a model. You could make one home or even a whole settlement! Make sure that you can share a few facts about the house/settlement and its features.
5. Art: Christmas is fast approaching so it would be lovely to have some beautiful wintery scenes around the classroom. Create a winter scene using media of your choice; paint, pencil, pastel or collage for example. Make sure you are able to talk about how you created your art and why you made the style/colour choices.

Reading

We expect the children to read 5 times a week – you can read to an adult (as it is always good to read aloud to practise your expression) or talk to your adult about what you have read.
