In English, we have practised writing our 'Day the Crayon Quit' stories from the point of view of some gymnastics equipment. We have been focussing on using an informal tone and contractions as well as a variety of punctuation.

In maths, we have been plotting our own line graphs about the weight of a horse over a number of weeks. We made sure we chose a sensible scale, labelled the x and y axis and drew our lines carefully with a ruler.

In history we have been looking at Danelaw and how well the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings co-existed. We did our own research to find out which areas of England remained under Viking control and which areas of England were controlled by the Anglo Saxons.
