Langtree EYFS Half Term Overview — Summer 2 2022

Number:

Nursery children will be understanding numbers 1-6 through counting, subitising (being able to see 3 and know it's 3 without needing to count them), recognising the numerals and representing number in different ways (pictures, objects, drawings etc). Reception will: be comparing quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same. They will be exploring and representing patterns within 10 such as odds, evens, double facts and halving.

Writing:

Nursery children will be learning early writing skills such as pre-writing shapes by mark making and begin to be able to write their name.

Reception will be writing for a variety of purposes and working to independently write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

Reading:

Nursery children will be learning to hear and know the initial sounds in words. They will engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary. They will be exploring rhythm and rhyme.

Reception children will be continuing to learn Phase 4 . In Phase 4 the children learn to blend and read words with adjacent consonants and segment and spell adjacent consonants. They will be learning tricky words : some, one, said, so, come, do, were, when, have, there, out, little, like, what.

Expressive Arts and Design:

We will be creating our own clay sea creatures and putting them into shoe box sea worlds that we will make for them.

We will be exploring a range of musical instruments and exploring pitch , rhythm and tone.

PSED

We are following the JIGSAW programme and will be looking at the module 'Changing Me' this term. This module looks at coping positively with change. We will label our bodies (knees, elbows, head etc) and discuss how to respect our bodies by keeping them healthy and happy (eating in moderation, exercise and deep breathing to keep calm). We also discuss transition into our next year group.

Physical Development

This term the children will be focusing on team games and Reception will be practicing for Sports Day. PE lessons take place on **Friday mornings.**

Outdoor learning sessions take place on a **Friday afternoon** with Mrs Heard in the school garden.

Communication and Language:

The children extend their vocabulary through shared stories, adults modelling it to them in their play and discovering topic specific words. We also play regular listening and attention games to develop their listening skills.

Understanding the World:

We will be learning all about sea creatures and their habitats. We will be learning about the different sea life we might see in the seas surrounding the UK and comparing them with sea life that is found in warmer climates. We will be comparing sea life now with the sea life we might have found long ago.

Trips and visits:

We are going on a local w park on Friday 17th May. We are holding a Stay and and Miss Weeks on Friday

We are hoping to visit Instow Beach for a class beach day week beginning 11th July. Date TBC.

We will be taking part in Sports Day– Dates TBC.
