



## **02/05/25 Home Learning Class F**

This week the children have continued with their new topic 'Amazing Animals'. They have been thinking about the job of a vet, exploring what a vet does and how they help animals. The children have been roleplaying looking after sick and injured animals using bandages and other medical equipment. We have read and discussed the book Mog and the VET. This week we have taught the children about Dog Safety through Dog's Trust lessons.

The reception children have been revising tricky words and phase 3 sounds along with writing dictated sentences. In maths they have been learning about number bonds to 5 and have been thinking about measures. The nursery children have now moved on to alliteration in their phonics learning and shape in their maths learning.

1. Go on an insect hunt. How many can you find in your garden or local park?
2. Make a home for your favourite animal thinking about where it likes to live.
