In English this week, we have practised writing complex sentences, thought about how we could show rather than tell the reader how a character is feeling and finally practised using sentence length for effect. We have also planned our recount of the jump from the edge of space and will aim to include all the skills we have been practising in this final piece.

In Maths we have continued with the bus stop method for division. We have consolidated our understanding of dividing by 1-digit numbers and some have moved on to dividing by 2-digit numbers and representing remainders as decimals.

In geography we looked at the Alps and the human and physical characteristics of this mountain range. We also named the 8 countries that they span and recapped the continent and hemisphere these countries are in.
