In English, we are focusing on Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo and how a story is structured.

In Maths, we are looking at the inverse calculation to check an answer.

In Geography, we are researching Indonesia.

In Science, we have been learning about the blood vessels.

Your child was assessed on the statutory Year 5/6 words at the beginning of this term. The words highlighted are the words your child needs to focus on this year. Don't worry about how many there are, as these words are new to them, just focus on five words at a time. Children will also be assessed again every half term and a new highlighted sheet will be given out with the expectation that fewer words will be highlighted. Spelling sheets need to be in school every day for opportunities to practise, so I advise they keep them in their reading records.

We expect the children to read 5 times a week – you can read to an adult (as it's always good to read aloud to practise your expression), or talk to your adult about what you have read. We have a Top 5 Readers of the week for those that have read 5 times.

Those that have read 5 times a week three times are rewarded a reading sticker and if they have read 5 times a week for 6 weeks, they can choose a reward from the lucky dip.
