Reporting absences

If your child is absent please phone the school office before 9.15am **everyday** your child is not in school. In the event we are unable to answer please leave an answer phone message.

Contact with school

If you have any concerns or something to discuss please make sure you do so as soon as you can directly with school. We are always here to listen and support and letting us know promptly really helps. The first step is to speak with your child's teacher as this is the person who sees them every day and will be able to address most things. After that, if you need further advice/support, you may book an appointment with a member of the senior leadership team via email. We will respond to emails within 5 working days.

Lateness

Just a reminder that your child must be settled into class ready for lessons to start at 9.05am. The gates open at 8.45am to allow time for this. Regular lateness can have a significant impact on your child's learning and contributes towards unauthorised absence. If this is something you are finding difficult, please get in touch with us so we can help support you to find a solution. We are always here ready to listen.

We also understand that sometimes unpredictable events may cause delays. In these instances, please contact the school as soon as you are able.
