

### 27/9/24 Home Learning Class F

This week, Class F have been thinking about the book 'I like books' to link with the Appledore Book Festival. On Thursday, the children took part in a whole school assembly lead by the author Gill Lewis and then had a class workshop. Layn Marlow led the workshop around her book Noah's Seal. The children listened very carefully to Layn's instructions and created their own "sand seal" like Noah did in the book. The children have also discussed books and the type of books they enjoy reading. They have voted for the book they would like to read.

In phonics, the reception children have been revisiting phase 1 phonics. They have played sound bingo games and then moved onto oral blending and segmenting – thinking about the sounds that make up words.

In maths, reception children have played a dice game concentrating on number recognition.

The Nursery children have continued their environmental sounds activities. In maths, they have carried out more activities concentrating on colour recognition.
