#### Car Park

What are the issues?

Overcrowding near the gate stopping the flow of traffic into the car park as parents drop at the gate. Concerns re safety of children walking in car park. Could parents be reminded about keeping the traffic flowing and parking in thew car park and walking your children down or watching them walk down if they are older.

Note to be added to newsletter 19/1/24. We have limited control as it is not our car park. All we can do is advise.

Re-issuing a previously used map to show guidelines for accessing the car park safely for all the children. Informing new parents of the guidelines. (Admin to action) Reminding parents that the car park is owned by the Parish Council and that they kindly allow us to use it. It is not only for school use and can be busy on market days or when the community is using the village hall. This is out of the school's control, but we must be mindful of other users and keeping our children as safe as possible.

### Teacher absence

Are TAs covering when teachers are out of class?

DC explained that we have 3 level 5 TAs who are able to cover classes. General TAs can be left to supervise if required but they do not cover classes. Teachers plan but Level 5 cover supervisors may follow plans.

Question about Mrs Symons covering 2 classes from K B-W. DC explained that she is still in ratio for children as there are few children between the 2 classes. Early Years practitioner is also working to support as well as a TA. And children and staff are able to flow through the two rooms.
