In English, we have written our final version of our 'Day the Crayons Quit' story. We have had some amazing ideas from very angry objects! The children made sure they thought about everything we have covered in this unit of work (punctuation, informal tone, complex sentences) and went back to edit and evaluate their work to check they had everything they needed.

In maths, we have just started looking at pie charts. We looked at a range of pie charts and thought about what each different one was showing and compared the data within them. When given an amount that the pie chart represents, we calculated how much each section of the pie was worth using our knowledge of calculating fractions of amounts.

In history, we have been looking at the hierarchy of Viking society – we learnt about the 4 different classes of people and the jobs that they would have to do. We then thought about how Viking society was different to our society today and whether there were any similarities.
