Welcome to 2024!

The children have settled back in well – into 2024 and also into our temporary classroom. 'Normal' class 1 learning has resumed, just in a different space. We have begun this term by exploring a huge range of fairy tales by reading, listening to and watching a variety of versions. Once we are familiar with these, we will be using our 'Mixed up' fairy tale books to create our own humorous versions.

In maths, year 1 have been reading and writing numbers to 100 and year 2 have been revising and developing their knowledge of place value up to and over 100 and also what happens when you add and subtract multiples of 10.

The children were immediately excited by our Geography topic as we investigated the world using Google Earth and then zoomed in to find England, Devon and then Langtree.

Reading Year 1.

Your child will be bringing home a book this week which they read with you and also during guided reading, the aim is that this book is read multiple times to practise their phonics and fluency. They can also bring home a picture book to share. Please aim to read with your child 3 times a week and sign their reading records.

There are new books allocated on bug club, please try to read the physical books with your child and also the ones online too.

Year 2. Your child now has an Accelerated reader book. They will keep this book and read it both at home and in 1-1 reading until they can read it fluently. They will also have guided reading sessions in class with Mrs Mitchell using an additional Accelerated reader book.
