

13/9/24 Home Learning Class F

Welcome back! We hope you have had a lovely summer break. The children have had a lovely two weeks sharing lots of stories, singing songs and learning how to use the different parts of the classroom.

This week, Class F have been thinking about the book 'What makes me a me?' and talked about what makes them special, what they like and what their favourite colours are. We have talked about where we can go in the classroom if we feel 'like a volcano'. We have also been practising our name writing with an adult.

In phonics, the reception children have been revisiting phase 1 phonics, they have taken part in rhythm and rhyme activities and we have been listening carefully to words that begin with the same letter 'alliteration'.

The Nursery children have now begun their phase 1 phonics learning starting with environmental sounds. They have been thinking about listening skills and gone on some listening walks.

In maths, reception children have sung lots of number songs and taken part in sorting activities. Nursery children have begun their maths learning starting with recognising colours.
