#### **Rules for Entries**

- Classes are open to residents of Langtree Parish and those outside the Parish who are members of Clubs or Societies that meet regularly. This includes Langtree Primary School, WI, History Group, Short Mat Bowls and children staying with family.
- Maximum 1 entry per class.
- Entry fee is 25p per exhibit. Under 14's free in own classes but they may enter other classes on payment of the fee. All entry forms with correct fee to be returned to Old Rectory Langtree or box at the Parish Hall by 8pm on Thursday 15th August
- Exhibits to be staged by 10.30am on 17th August. Doors open at 8.30am but will be locked at 10.30am.
- No exhibitors or any other person except judges, stewards and committee members to be present during judging. Entries should not have been exhibited before.
- Exhibitors must provide own vases, plates etc
- All exhibits of Fruit, Flowers or Vegetables must be grown by the exhibitor. (Except flower arrangements)
- Prizes in each class 1<sup>st</sup> £1.50p 2<sup>nd</sup> £1.00 3<sup>rd</sup> 50p. However, judges may withhold prizes if there are insufficient entries in any one class.
- The decision of the judges is final.

### **SECTION 4 - CHILDREN'S CLASSES 42-65**

Age to be clearly stated on all entry forms in years and months

#### Age 4 and under

- 42. A collage of Olympic colours
- 43. An Olympic torch made from junk
- 44. A drawing or colouring of a toy
- 45. A baby woodland animal made from fir cone(s)
- 46. A picture made from leaves and or pasta

# Ages 5-7 (key stage 1)

- 47. A face on a plate made from fruit and or vegetables
- 48. Paint the Olympic rings
- 49. Photograph of animal or plant
- 50. Make a diorama -Using a shoe box without the lid place it on its long side and create a 3D model of an underwater scene or a jungle . Max of 3 bought items may be included
- 51. A model of an insect made from scrap materials. (Don't forget it needs 6 legs!)
- 52. A plate of foraged blackberries
- 53. Colouring picture
- 54. A flower arrangement in a jam jar
- 55. An item I have made in the last year last year

#### Ages 8 – 11 (Key stage 2) and Ages 12 – 14 (to be judged separately)

- 56. Construct a diorama (as class 50)
- 57. Homemade biscuits (5)

- 58. Miniature model of a play park on a plate or seed tray
- 59. Photograph of a vehicle
- 60. Photograph showing Action
- 61. Poster to advertise advantages of electric cars(A4)
- 62. An item I have made in the last year
- 63. A painting or drawing of an endangered animal
- 64. 4 small cakes baked and decorated
