This week, Class F have been busy with a variety of activities. Home Learning

Projects: Please choose one (or more!) of the following options to complete over half term.

- 1. Our learning this half term is around the topic of Space. We have been singing 5 Little Men in a Flying Saucer. You can find a lovely, animated version of this on BBC Teach which you could share with your child along with other songs such as Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star.
- 2. Go outside with your child when it is dark and look at the sky. Discuss what you can see. Can you count any stars? Can you see the moon? The children could draw a picture showing what they saw to share with the class.
- 3. Make a rocket out of junk modelling materials e.g. plastic bottles, kitchen roll tubes, pringles tube etc. The children could bring this in to show the class.



The children have a phonics book linked to their phonics learning. Please read with your child every day and record in their reading record book. Please ensure your child's book bag is brought into school <u>every</u> <u>day</u> so the adults in school can listen to them read.
