Reminder: School Dinner - Price Changes

Following the email sent out to all parents, from 1st May 2024, we will be increasing the price we charge as a Federation for School Dinners and our Preschool/Nursery at both Bishops Tawton Primary School and Langtree Community School.

· School Dinners will rise from £2.40 to £2.60 in May and then to £2.70 in September 2024.

· Bishops Tawton Pre-school and Langtree Community School Nursery costs:

For 3 years olds, £4.50 an hour-remains the same.
