

4/10/24 Home Learning Class F

This week, Class F have been thinking about the book 'Famer Duck' and have been thinking about what harvesting means and the link to Harvest Festival. The children have enjoyed listening to the story, have thought about how Farmer Duck feels to be doing all the work on the farm whilst the farmer stays in bed eating chocolates and have sequenced pictures depicting the story.

In phonics, the reception children have started Phase 2 phonics and have learnt the sounds s, a, t and p. They have used playdough to form the letters and have practised writing the graphemes.

In maths, the reception children have started their Numberblocks lessons to learn the numbers 1 & 2. They have taken part in activities around these numbers e.g. finding 2 of something.

The Nursery children have continued their environmental sounds activities and have enjoyed listening to sounds and trying to work out what thing is making that sound. In maths, they have carried out more activities concentrating on colour recognition before moving on to matching.
