

11/10/24 Home Learning Class F

This week, Class F have been continuing to think about the book 'Famer Duck'. Last week, the children investigated sunflowers that had developed seeds. They then used tweezers and their fingers to pull the seeds out. These seeds have now been used to create their own sunflowers using yellow paint, paper plates and the sunflower seeds they harvested. The children also listened to and learnt the song Dingle Dangle Scarecrow with actions.

In phonics, the reception children have started Phase 2 phonics and have now learnt the sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m and d. They have been writing the graphemes for these sounds and started to sound out and blend CVC words. In maths, the reception children have continued with their numberblocks lessons with the numbers 3 and 4.

The Nursery children have continued their environmental sounds activities such as playing sound lotto and a game identifying sounds. In maths, the children have been matching with activities such as matching socks and patterns.
