SATs are over, and the summer term is here - a time for reflection, celebration, and planning for the new academic year. While this term brings excitement, it also marks the start of major transitions, whether moving to a new school year or simply coping with the change in routine that the summer holidays bring. For many young people, this period of change can bring up feelings of anxiety and worry.

As you may already know, Lumi Nova is a digital therapeutic app designed to support children aged 7-12 years to overcome their fears and worries, whether related to transition, sleeping alone, making friends, or visiting crowded places, step by step through an intergalactic game adventure.

Using Lumi Nova during this time can be a fun and engaging way for students to prepare for the upcoming transitions and challenges of the summer, helping them learn to manage their fears related to new environments, a change in routine, or the prospect of starting a new school.
