The children had the most fantastic time at Rosemoor yesterday. We began the day with a Plants workshop run by the Rosemoor staff. The children recapped the structure of a flower and tree and then discussed what each part of a plant was responsible for. We did some role-play with one child pretending to be a seed and the other children had to encourage it to grow with water, sunlight, air and soil.

We learnt about Nasturtium flowers and Maxim taught us that they can be eaten and that they taste peppery. We then planted some of our own. After that, we explored the gardens to collect fallen items such as petals and leaves then returned to the education centre to make some flower art. In the afternoon, we walked the gardens some more, the children were amazing around the public, very polite and well behaved. We then did some more art and played some games. A thoroughly great day for all.

Year 1
