In English this week, we have started looking at our new text – The Day the Crayons Quit. We have explored some new vocabulary that the author has used in the text as well as having a go at writing in the style of Oliver Jeffers.

In maths, we have been looking at the column method for addition and have thought about when we might need to use this method in real life situations. We have also been using a range of methods to solve additions and subtractions mentally including compensation, partitioning, adjusting and using known facts.

In history we have been looking at what happened when the Anglo Saxons came to England, why they chose to settle here and what a settlement looked like. We wrote diary entries as if we were an Anglo Saxon and described what our journey from our homeland was like and how we felt when we arrived in England.
